
SOMEONE SAID YES. NOW WHAT?

- 1. Make sure they understand**

Ask: “What do you believe about Jesus?” and “What do you think it means to follow Him?” Listen. This isn't a test.

- 2. Walk through the Gospel again**

God loves us. Sin separates us from God. Jesus died for our sins and rose again. Salvation is God's gift. We receive it through faith in Jesus.

- 3. Invite them to respond**

Romans 10:9. They can talk to God themselves. If they want help, you can help them pray. There isn't a perfect formula.

- 4. Celebrate**

A person has decided to follow Jesus. Celebrate and pray with them.

- 5. Tell your leader**

Bring in your mission leader or local ministry partner because this person needs discipleship beyond this moment.

- 6. Connect them locally**

Your team may leave in three days. They still live here. Help connect them with the local church or ministry you're serving alongside.

If They Want Help Praying

There are no magic words. What matters is that they understand the Gospel and are genuinely placing their faith in Jesus. If they aren't sure what to say to God, you can help them with a prayer like this:

Dear God,

I know that I have sinned and I cannot save myself. I believe Jesus died for my sins and rose again. I believe Jesus is Lord, and I put my trust in Him. Please forgive me and make me new.

I want to follow Jesus with my life. Help me learn to know You, trust You, and live the way You want me to live. Thank You for loving me, forgiving me, and giving me new life through Jesus.

In Jesus name I pray, Amen.
